Notes from the Pastor:

Corpus Christi:

This past weekend's procession for Corpus Christi and the celebration of the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the building of Blessed Sacrament church was a wonderful display of faith. Thank you again to all who helped and to all who participated in the procession and who came to the luncheon afterward. The Lord blessed us with a beautiful day and the "official counter's" calculation was that 297 people participated. I think this is truly a good sign of faith in action.

Serra Club Golf Outing:

The Serra Club of La Crosse sponsored a golf outing this past Wednesday to raise money for vocations in the diocese. I could not help but notice that Blessed Sacrament was well represented by golfers and those who worked on this very worthwhile project. If you missed this year there is always next year. The Serra Club, along with others, like the Knights of Columbus, does work to promote vocations to priesthood and religious life year round.

A Second Collection next week for Aquinas:

As you know our parish financially supports Aquinas Catholic Schools because tuition is only part of the cost of the education. The pastors of the parishes involved with Aquinas Catholic Schools agreed to take up a voluntary second collection this coming weekend. *"Our Aquinas Catholic Schools System is anticipating a budget shortfall for the fiscal year ending June 30. The amount of the shortfall is about \$57,000. This is due to two principal factors. The first is that the assessment for teachers' retirement, which was billed to the school system by the Diocesan Finance Office in March, was \$28,000 higher than anticipated. The second is that donations, which make up a large portion of the ACS annual budget, have been less this year even though the number of donors has increased. In order to make up as much of this shortfall as possible, the pastors of our deanery parishes have agreed to take up a second collection on the weekend of June 19-20. Catholic education is an essential element of our parishes' mission and we hope you will be as generous as possible."*
