His Holiness and the contagious power of goodness.

This past week the Holy Father gathered the priests of Rome together in St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome and discussed the connection of faith, the Eucharist and the work of charity.

"The faith," said the Pope, "can never be taken for granted, because each generation needs to receive this gift through announcement of the Gospel and knowledge of the truth that Christ revealed to us." It is also necessary "for people to have a more profound knowledge of the mystery of the Body and Blood of the Lord."

The Holy Mass celebrated with attention to the rich detail of gestures and signs, allows us to enter into a reality which we do not create but which is given to us and which embraces heaven and earth and the entirety of past, present and future. The Pope said: *"The best catechesis on the Eucharist is the Eucharist well celebrated."* He encouraged the faithful *"to rediscover the fruitfulness of Eucharistic adoration"* by remaining with Jesus present in the Holy Sacrament.

"Drawing nourishment from Him, we free ourselves from the bonds of individualism. And through our communion with Him, we ourselves become, all together, a single unit, His mystical Body," said the Pope. *"We discover that we are all members of one large family, that of the children of God in which each individual is blessed with a specific grace for the common good."*

"When we receive Christ, the love of God expands inside us, radically modifying our hearts and making us capable of gestures which, by the contagious power of goodness, can transform the lives of people around us."

In our Parish's joyful celebration of the Eucharist, and our time in silent Adoration, and in our work of charity, may we all be part of the "contagious power of goodness."
