Corpus Christi and the 60th year of the church building

A lot of preparation has been going into planning the 60th anniversary of the dedication Blessed Sacrament church. We will celebrate that fittingly on the Feast of Corpus Christi on June 6th. Please join your fellow parishioners for our procession after the 10:00 am Mass on Sunday and for lunch following in the Parish Center.

The procession on Corpus Christi is a good witness to our faith and a wonderful way to commemorate the blessing and dedication of the church. Even if Mass were celebrated only once each day in this building there would have been 21,900 Masses said here. Add in the extra masses on weekends, wedding, funeral, and confirmation Masses and all the daily masses said by associate priests before the days of concelebrated masses and the number is much much greater.

Think of the graces poured out into our world by the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, when Christ again becomes present as on Mount Calvary and that first Easter morn. It is most fitting that we celebrate together the fact that in this place, where God joins us in the Holy Eucharist, we have over the many years worshiped our Lord and then taken the grace of that worship into our world to make it a better place.

We adopted the phrase “built of living stones” to recognize the fact that the church building would be incomplete without the ongoing work of evangelization by the members of the parish. We are truly built of the living members of our parish family who serve the community and serve each other in love and in faith. By God’s grace may we continue for the next 60 years carrying on the fine legacy of Blessed Sacrament Parish.
